In the Name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit

A very familiar opening to prayer...yes? But do you know it is a prayer within itself? Do you know the depth of meaning the Sign of the Cross encompasses? It wasn't until I heard Jeff Cavins comment on this gesture that I fully appreciated its significance. It is because of my presence in a Bible Study group that I had the opportunity to even hear this teaching!

The sign of the cross is closely tied to baptism. Jesus told the apostles, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Mt 28:19).

It is a mark that we belong to Christ. "...**The baptized person dedicates the day to the glory of God and calls on the Savior's grace which lets him act in the Spirit as a child of the Father.** The sign of the cross strengthens us in temptations and difficulties. (CCC 2157) How comforting to know that God's Grace is ever present to us...through a simple gesture.

According Catholic author Bert Ghezzi: "We are committing the whole self to Christ. In moving our hands from our foreheads to our hearts and then both shoulders, we are asking God's blessing for our mind, our passions and desires, our very bodies." Also, "In invoking the name of God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, we are affirming our belief in a triune God."

As St. Paul wrote in Ephesians 6, "Put on the armor of God so that you may be able to stand firm against the tactics of the devil. ... take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God."

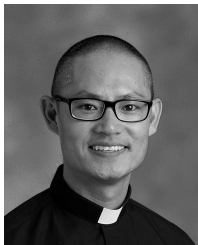
In conclusion, the words of St. Cyril of Jerusalem especially speaks to the daily moments of our lives. "Let us not then be ashamed to confess the Crucified. Be the Cross our seal, made with boldness by our fingers on our brow, and on everything; over the bread we eat, and the cups we drink; in our comings in, and goings out; before our sleep, when we lie down and when we rise up; when we are in the way, and when we are still."

As a gesture often made in public, the Sign of the Cross is a simple way to witness our faith to others. Share this new appreciation. I did so with my mom, and she often reminds me of the many times she now makes The Sign of the Cross throughout her day!

May I also draw your attention to our upcoming Sacred Scripture study: **Eucharist, Discovering the Mass in the Bible**. In ten sessions, YOU will open Sacred Scripture and deepen your understanding of the mystery and wonder that is the Eucharist – and how it will transform your life. Begins 9/26 (Monday morning) and 9/27 (Tuesday eves)
