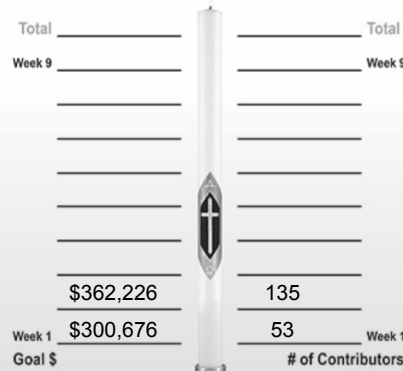

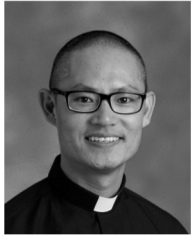

Since the launching of our “myParish” app, we currently have an average of 400 active users. Our goal is to have as many parishioners as possible to use our app daily. MyParish app provides us with tremendous spiritual guidance as we yearn to grow in faith, love, and charity in Christ our Lord and Savior.

Our myParish app not only enables us to integrate our goal of at least 10 minutes of prayer a day, but also allows us to stay connected with our parish and our Mother Church. The app has daily Scripture readings, reflections, weekly audio homily under “Podcast” and “Word on Fire”, news, parish weekly bulletin, parish full year calendar, instant messages, and many more features that help feed our spiritual growth, with just a click a way. If you haven’t had a chance to download and use it, please do so as soon as you can.

There are a couple of ways that one can download and use our parish app. One can go to a smartphone’s “app store” and search for “my parish”. Select “myParish –Catholic Life Every Day” app to download. Once downloaded, open “myParish” app and select “next” until you see “find my parish” button.
